Sound Check: 5:45 Stage

We will take the stage to warm up, and rehearse a few key spots to get used to the sound of the hall.

House Opens: 6:30 Patriots Theater

It is my understanding that the Theater will open at 6:30 for attendees to take their seats. This is a big hall, so bring your whole family, relatives, and close friends. General seating, no ticket required.


Concert Begins: 7:00
